Trading Spaces: From Earth to the Moon

This mission will look back at the exciting days of Apollo and will look ahead to the future of space exploration: the Moon, Mars and beyond.

March 12

Mission to Mars

On this mission to the Red Planet, campers will plan a trip to Mars – how far they would travel, how long it would take, what supplies they would need and how to survive in the Martian environment.

April 16

International Space Station

This mission will center on building International Space Station models and flying them from the top of the Wernher Von Braun Tower at SSC.

May 14

Return to Flight

Activities will illustrate the propulsion principles that will return the Space Shuttle to flight. Campers will learn about STS-114, NASA's Return-to-Flight Mission, and will design, build and launch rockets!
